**Subject: INFORMATION REGARDING ACHIEVEMENTS OF EXCISE,
TAXATION & NARCOTICS CONTROL DEPARTMENT.**

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to state that the overall performance of Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Department, including all significant achievements made from **March 2024** till **31st January 2025** is as under:

i. The Sindh Control of Narcotic Substance Act 2024.

The Government of Sindh has passed the Sindh Control of Narcotic Substances Act, 2024 (**Sindh CNS Act-2024**), to control narcotics, psychotropic substances, and precursor chemicals. This legislation also controls production, processing, and trafficking within the province

ii. The Provincial Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Act 2024

The Government of Sindh introduced the Provincial Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Act 2024 to amend and update the Provincial Motor Vehicles Ordinance 1965. This amendment aims to bring the ordinance in line with modern requirements, efficient tax collection. The Act is expected to increase revenue for the government through imposing fines and fees for late vehicle registration/transfer. Key features of the Act include:

- a) Penalty on defaults of registration.
- b) Issuance of series of number plates.
- c) Data sharing relating to motor vehicles manufactured/assembled.
- d) Substitution of Section 32, sale of Motor Vehicle, Transfer of ownership and seizure of tampered vehicles.

iii. Policy against Drug Abuse in Educational Institutes in Sindh, 2024.

Government of Sindh introduced a Policy against Drug Abuse in Educational Institutions in Sindh, 2024. Key features of the Policy is as under:

- a) In order to save the students an awareness against drug abuse prevention may invariably be included in both formal and informal health curricula.
- b) Vigorous anti-drugs campaign may also be launched.
- c) Sell and usage of Cigarette, Pan, Gutka, Chalia, Sheesha and vape should be prohibited in all educational institutions.
- d) Parent – Teachers meetings should be held in the schools on a regular basis to monitor the behaviors / suspicious activities of such student.



iv. **Constitution of High Powered Monitoring Committee.**

To ensure strict implementation of the **Policy against Drug Abuse in Educational Institutions in Sindh, 2024**, a High Powered Monitoring Committee under the Chairmanship of Minister, Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Sindh is constituted including senior members from School Education, Colleges, Universities & Boards Department, Health Department, Home Department, Anti-Narcotics Force, Sindh Police and other concerned Departments. The Committee empowered to propose and recommend actions against the delinquents pertaining to no-implementations of policy. After constitution of the HPMC, 4 meetings were held and various decisions were taken to implement the policy.

v. **Auction of Premium Number Plates.**

The Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Department, Government of Sindh has conducted first time in the history of the Department a physical fund-raising event for sale of **Premium Number Plates** for construction of Houses for flood affectees of the Province of Sindh.

vi. **Biometric verification**

Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Department, Government of Sindh introduced the Compulsory biometric verification for registration of any new motor vehicles or at the time of transfer of motor vehicle, first time.

vii. **Police Training.**

The Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Department, Government of Sindh has arranged for the first a training program of more than 400 Excise Constables from Police Training Centers in order to enhance their competency, arm handling and expertise of combating with drug mafia.

viii. **Online auction of Prime & Premium Number Plates.**

The Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Department, Government of Sindh organized for the first time an online event for sale of Prime Category Number Plates and Premium Category number plates.

ix. **Cashless & Contact Less System.**

Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Department, Government of Sindh devised a mechanism to facilitate general public for various services in the manner of cashless and contactless:

- a) Order new security featured number plate.
- b) Pay annual tax online.
- c) Pay transfer fees / registration fees online
- d) Pay Smart card issue fee online, etc.



x. Online collection of Professional Tax

The Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Department, Government of Sindh, has made a significant move by introducing a digital mechanism for collecting professional tax. The new system is expected to improve efficiency, reduce errors, and increase transparency in tax collection. It will also make it easier for taxpayers to pay their professional taxes online, reducing the need for physical visits to tax offices.

This digital transformation is part of the department's efforts to modernize its services and provide better facilities to the public.

xi. Collection of Property Tax.

The Government of Sindh has devolved the collection of Property Tax from Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Department to Local Government. Although the ET&NC Department is no longer collecting Property Tax, still providing guidance and technical support to the Local Councils, Local Government Department as & when required.

xii. Tax Collection.

The Excise, Taxation & Narcotics Control Department has successfully met all its targets for the Financial Year 2023-24. Moreover, the department is also on track to achieving its targets for the current Financial Year 2024-25. This achievement underscores the department's commitment to effective revenue collection and public service. The details are attached as Annexure-A.
